- Conduct the site reviews
- Report site status to Division of Health Improvement

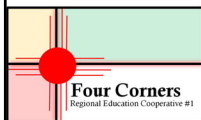


For participating sites



1. Sign and return the MOU*
2. Complete the Site Information Form*
3. Prepare your testing site based on the checklist*
4. Complete the CLIA Quality Assurances Form*
5. Schedule and facilitate your virtual site visits
6. Work with your SHA on testing requirements

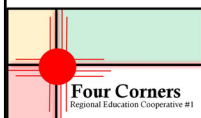

Virtual site visits



- Three virtual site visits ~ 90-day intervals
- Mobile device with video capability
- 15- to 20-minutes per visit
- Site visitor follows the site review checklist
- School administrator receives report
- Follow-up visit if necessary



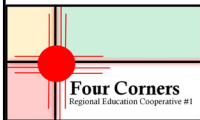
