2. EEDW Yr 2 planning and anticipated outcomes - Bowman  
The Annual report was submitted with some changes proposed. There was quite a bit of money left over. Proposed using for schools, travel and future meetings. What discussions would there be? There was discussion on bring IHE's and ECH's together for dual support. What could be accomplished? Mr. Kerr stated that communication is valuable and depends on who you talk to. A human contact is needed when students are taking online courses to help students connect the dots. He said Dona Ana is a 24-hour campus. They are there to help the students when they need the help. It adds a personal element to the course when the students know he is available to them. He noted that some students in internships, who also have jobs, sometimes have to quit their job to complete the internship. This creates a hardship, especially for low income. Jaime agreed and said it is important to get people together and also include students. They need to be part of the conversation. How can we create that a bridge so students aren't marginalized?

David discussed the Career videos. Looking to caption in multiple languages. What about the Native languages? Once the career videos are released, could they be used in an IHE setting? Daniel said he could see quite a few ways to use the videos. It would be helpful for students who don't know what they are going to do to hear the stories. If the message is properly communicated; it would be helpful. Jaime mentioned the participants in the videos are diverse which was the goal.

3. Recruitment updates, Next steps - Sanders – So far, Arrowhead is the only participating school that hasn't turned in an MOU yet. They are in the process. ABQ ECH would not be participating. She said, with the schools on board with MOU's signed, there should be 1134 students. All the schools have access upload their rosters which is supposed to be done by Friday.
